Coffin requirements for the natural burial ground

Only coffins and caskets constructed from natural, biodegradable materials are permitted within the natural burial ground. Suitable materials include solid wood, wicker, bamboo, willow, cardboard, or other environmentally sustainable alternatives. Coffins must be free from plastic, metal components, synthetic materials, varnishes, or chemical treatments that may impede natural decomposition. Any internal linings, fittings, handles, and nameplates must also be fully biodegradable. Lake View Bereavement Centre reserves the right to refuse any coffin that does not meet these requirements.
